








Figure 4.1: GDP per inhabitant, in PPS, by NUTS 2 regions, 2007 ⁽¹⁾



GDP > 90% of EU-27 average






realignment 2014-2020

- concentrating on the Europe 2020 strategy's priorities
- defining new key sectors: digital agenda, low-carbon economy, youth employment
- incentive: performance reserve
- administrative simplification → focusing on results
- integrated programming



socio-political interpretation

how far does a regional gain in opportunities influence the life situations of the citizens?


- growth political instrumentalisation of the structural funds in the sense of the Lisbon strategy
→ social- and economic policy as „harmonic twin “ in the sense of a positive interdependence
- investments in human capital (ESF) increase the chances to participate in growth processes
- „trickle-down-effects“= transportation of growth effects (e.g. via households over via societal redistribution ← national social security systems)
- due to its social development effects – besides the economic development effects - the cohesion policy can be evaluated as an important policy field. Cohesion policy is a part of a wider **social policy and a policy focusing on the persons' life circumstance**, an important complement for an economic growth policy
- in the long run structural funds are an incremental base for the European social policy. Only through the approximation of living conditions in Europa, integrated European social standards might become a realistic goal


